


What is the best job in America?

LANDING A JOB IN A GROWING FIELD IS ONE THING,
BUT FINDING A JOB THAT WON'T STRESS YOU OUT IS ANOTHER



his chart works: we compared 40 of a wide variety of jobs, focusing on two key factors. **STRESS** is a score (higher numbers are more stressful) from Glassdoor.com based on 11 factors, including travel and commute times. **GROWTH** is the projected change in the number of jobs in that field from 2012 to 2022, as forecast by the Bureau of Labor Statistics.
